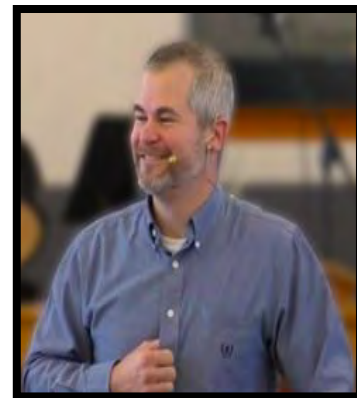

Brothers and Sisters,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ! I pray you are well and find yourselves and your families blessed greatly by our heavenly Father. I am looking forward to the Super Sabbath on October 7, and truly hope you are all able to come worship and fellowship with us. **Bro. Tim Steinhauser, Pastor of the Stanberry, MO church, will be the guest speaker.** He will be preaching two sermons, sharing Spirit-filled biblical truth and wisdom tied to our theme of Faith in Community, and our need to be *growing up in the body of Christ*.

We will begin the day with a continental breakfast and gather in prayer together for God's blessing and leading over the events of the day. This will also include an opportunity to share prayer requests and testimonies. We will then have Sabbath school classes for children (4-12), youth (13-18), and adults. ***We are asking for each church to provide at least one volunteer to assist with the Children's AM class, and one for the PM Children's Church.***


The worship services will include congregational praise, specials, testimonies, a collection of offerings, and a sermon from Brother Steinhauser. A potluck-style Fellowship Lunch will be provided between services. **All guests are invited to contribute to the potluck, but it is not a requirement - especially those traveling long-distance to attend.** The adult class and both services will have Spanish translation available (limited devices - first come-first serve). **Each church represented at the Super Sabbath is encouraged to come prepared with 1 or 2 specials to share.** These can be an individual, a duet or small group, or a large group and can be songs, skits, or other brief presentations that glorify the Lord. We will also have a few openings in each service for brief testimonies that relate to the *Faith in Community: Growing Up in the Body of Christ* theme.

Please Note: *RSVP by Oct. 2 is required for all specials and testimonies, to ensure proper scheduling for the day. Openings are limited and will be filled in the order we are notified, so please respond ASAP to secure a spot in the program.*

We will conclude our time together, after sunset, with a Pizza & Game Night that will include a Team Bible-Trivia Competition. Please see the included Bible Trivia Competition Rules and Preparation for more information. Please also come prepared with a freewill donation to offer for the pizza and beverages.
